To educate consumers about the history, process and quality of the K J Wood Distillers, LLC brands and products and to establish core brand positioning when interacting with members of the press or public.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide product tasting to public and industry guests
- Be familiar with each product, manufacturing process, and product category
- Must follow CDOR rules and regulations at all times
- Perform retail sales (if age appropriate), including credit card processing and cash transactions
- Staff outside promotional events as available
- Clean glassware and stock other supplies as needed
- Adhere to distillery dress code & hygiene standards
- Other duties as may be assigned by Management
